Frank Brandyberry Funeral Held Today

Funeral services were held this morning at the Zwick funeral home for Frank S. Brandyberry, 79, of 315 North 10th street, who died at 4:35 p.m. Saturday at the Adams county memorial hospital following an illness of 10 days. The Rev. A. C. Underwood officiated, and burial was in the Decatur cemetery.

Born in Monroe Aug. 4, 1882, he was a son of Emm and Rachel Hahn-Brandyberry, and was married to Ada F. Barber March 5, 1904.

Mr. Brandyberry was an electrical engineer at the municipal light and power plant for 34 years until his retirement in 1952.

Surviving are his wife; four sons, Gregg of Fort Wayne, Robert of Bluffton, Chester of Fort Wayne, and Randolph of Decatur; three daughters, Major Marcella Brandyberry of San Antonia, Tex., Mrs. Luther (Gertrude) Waddy of Mineral Falls, Tex., and Miss Florence Brandyberry of Decatur; 10 grandchildren; one great-grandchild; one sister, Mrs. William Martz of Decatur, and two half-brothers, Harve Knavel of Sturgis, Mich., and Max Knavel of Decatur.
