Mrs. John Bright Is Taken By Death - Funeral Services Saturday Morning

Mrs. Lulu Bright, 71, of 815 North Third street, wife of John A. Bright, died at 7:10 o'clock Wednesday evening at the College Hill hospital in Dayton [Montgomery Co], O. She had been in failing health for the past 12 years and critical since Nov. 11.

Mr. and Mrs. Bright have been living in Dayton with a daughter, Mrs. Vera Turner, for several months.

She was born in Decatur July 26, 1881, a daughter of Clinton and Jane Steele-Cloud, and was married to John A. Bright March 19, 1902.

Mrs. Bright was a member of the First Methodist church.

O. Swoveland of Berne and Mrs. Letta Peters of Fort Wayne. Two brothers preceded her in death.
