Annis May Brown, 60, 503 W. Adams St., wife of Bill Brown, died at 8:40 p.m. Tuesday at her home. She had been in ill health since Nov. 20.

She retired in 1982 as secretary at Bellmont Junior High School after 20 years of service.

Mrs. Brown was a member of the First United Methodist Church, where she served as children's choir director, and was a member of the United Methodist Women.

Born in Adams County on April 25, 1923, she was the daughter of Russell and Nora Feasel-Merriman, and was united in marriage to Bill Brown on Oct. 28, 1942; he survives. Mrs. Brown was raised by her grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Charles Feasel.
