Hubert E. Butler Dies Last Evening

Hubert E. Butler, 50, who resided in St. Mary's township, three and one-half miles south east of Decatur, died at 6:35 o'clock Thursday evening at the Adams county memorial hospital, following an illness of four weeks.

He was born in Washington township June 20, 1910, a son of Harve and Amelia Winters-Butler, and was married to Luella Kelley March 9, 1934.

Mr. Butler, a lifelong resident of this community, was an employe of the state highway department until ill health forced his retirement in January.

Surviving are his wife; five sons and one daughter, Thomas, Joseph, Paul, Jack, James and Judy Butler, all of in or near Decatur; six grandchildren, and two brothers, Harold Butler of Fort Wayne, and Robert Butler of Decatur.
