Ralph Butler Dies After Heart Attack

Native of Decatur Dies This Morning

Ralph Butler, 50, a native of Decatur, died suddenly of a heart attack at 4:30 o'clock this morning at the Avington memorial hospital in Hatboro, Pa., a suburb of Philadelphia.

Mr. Butler, an employe of the Dana Corp, in Toledo, O., was on a business trip to Philadelphia when he was stricken by the heart attack.

He was born in Decatur Aug. 16, 1908, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Samuel Butler, but left this city a number of years ago.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Bernard Bellisari, and one son, Charles R. Butler, both of Columbus, O.; one brother, Arthur (Bill) Butler of Decatur, and two sisters, Mrs. J. R. (Ireta) Peterson of Terre Haute, and Mrs. Ross Tindall of Van Wert, O.

Funeral arrangements have not been completed, but the body will be returned to the Zwick funeral home here for services.
