

FORREST DeBOLT'S BROTHER, 63, DIES

Lloyd E. (Hezy) DeBolt, 63, of Decatur, who was stricken with a stroke suddenly at his home in Decatur Saturday morning, died in Decatur Hospital at 12:05 a.m. today. He was a brother of Forrest DeBolt of Bluffton Route 1.

A 43-year employe at Central Soya Co., in Decatur, where he was employed at the time of his death, Mr. DeBolt was a member of that firm's Quarter Century Club.
