MRS. MARY DEBOLT IS TAKEN BY DEATH - Funeral Services Set for Wednesday

Mrs. Mary Jane Debolt, widow of Alphus DeBolt, died at 1:30 o'clock Sunday afternoon at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Roy Chilcote following an illness of six weeks.

Born in Van Wert County, O., Dec. 31, 1875, she was a daughter of John and Margaret Heath. She was married to Alphus DeBolt April 29, 1900. Her husband died Oct. 12 of last year.

She was a member of the Trinity Evangelical United Brethren church.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Chilcote of this city and Mrs. Louis Hendricks of Fort Wayne; two sons, Chalmer DeBolt of Decatur and Raymond Debolt of Fort Wayne; eight grandchildren; two stepgrandchildren and three great-grandchildren. One son preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the Black Funeral Home and at 2:30 o'clock at the Trinity Evangelical United Brethren Church, the Rev. John E. Chambers officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur Cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 7 o'clock this evening.
