Wm. Draper Found Dead This Morning

Funeral Services Thursday Afternoon

William Draper, 76, was found dead early this morning at his home, 828 North Eleventh street. Death was attributed to a heart attack. His body was found by a sister, Mrs. Mary Laisure, who lives in the adjacent house.

He was born in Auglaise county, O., Sept 8, 1873, a son of Jeremiah and Mary Haggard-Draper. His wife, Effie, died March 24, 1921.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Florence Bleeke of Root township, and Mrs. Stella Wood of Washington, D. C.; five grandchildren and two sisters, Mrs. Laisure and Mrs. Lucy Small of Milwaukee, Wis. Two daughters are deceased.
