Mary C. Elzey Dies Suddenly

Mrs. Mary Elzey Dies Monday Evening Of Heart Attack

Funeral Services will be held Thursday afternoon for Mrs. Mary C. Elzey, 78, pioneer Decatur resident, who died suddenly Monday evening at 4 o'clock.

Death was due to a heart attack. The deceased was born in Champaign county, Ohio November 5, 1860, the daughter of Rudolph and Elizabeth Venis. She came here with her parents when three years old. Her husband, Thomas Elzey, preceded her in death.

She was a charter member of the First United Brethren church in this city.

Surviving are two children, Mrs. Charles Howell of Marion and Erwin Elzey of this city; a sister, Mrs. Charles Howell of Defiance, Ohio and a brother, Sylvester Venis of Decatur. Three grandchildren and five great grandchildren also survive.

Services will be held Thursday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the home and at 2 o'clock at the church with Rev. James A. Weber officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery.

The body will be returned to the home Wednesday morning from the S. E. Black funeral home and may be viewed there until time for the funeral.
