Kenneth Kiser Dies Suddenly Last Night Funeral Services Friday Afternoon

Kenneth L. Kiser, 40, of Decatur route 6, a lineman for the city light and power plant, died suddenly at 9:30 o'clock Tuesday night at the Adams county memorial hospital. He had been undergoing treatment for a kidney infection for several days when the blood clot developed last night, causing his unexpected death.
