Steven L. Kiser, 51, Decatur, died at 7:35 p.m. Monday in Adams County Memorial Hospital after a short illness.

He was born on November 23, 1953, in Decatur to Vernon and Mary E. Schnepf Kiser; he lives in California and she lives in Decatur.

He married Janet S. Ogg on October 10, 1987; she also survives.

He was a senior systems application engineer for airborne and military communications systems at Raytheon Systems in Fort Wayne.

He was a member of Zion United Church of Christ in Decatur, an elder and a former youth leader, along with his wife.

He was also a member of American Legion Post 43 in Decatur, having served in the U. S. Navy as a gunner's mate from 1972 - 1978, partly during the Vietnam War.

The only other survivor is his brother, Randy Kiser of Knoxville, Tennessee.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Friday in Zion United Church of Christ, with burial in Decatur Cemetery, with graveside military rites by the color guard from American Legion Post 43.

Visiting hours are 2 to 4 and 6 to 8 p.m. Thursday in Zwick and Jahn Funeral Home and 10 to 11 a.m. Friday in the church.

Preferred memorials are to the window fund at the church, to Crossroads Home, and to the angel funds within the Adams County Community Foundation.
