E. A. MALLONEE EXPIRED TODAY

Former Well Known Farmer Of Root Township, Died At Hospital

Emory A. Mallonee, 56, former well known farmer of Root township, but lately of Rome City, died at the Adams County Memorial hospital here at 8:30 o'clock this morning, following an extended illness of paralysis. Mr. Mallonee had suffered his third stroke of paralysis. He was brought to the local hospital two weeks ago last Monday.

Mr. Mallonee was a son of Thomas W. and Susanna Baker Mallonee, and was born in Root township, Adams county, November 21, 1867. He grew to manhood in Root township and later purchased his father's farm, which formerly had been owned by his grandfather. He was married to Rachel E. Stephenson, January 22, 1893, and the happy couple resided on the farm in Root township until four years ago when they moved to Rome City. Mr. Mallonee had been ill for the last two years.

No children were born to Mr. and Mrs. Mallonee. Besides the wife, Mr. Mallonee is survived by a step-mother, Mrs. Sarah Ellen Mallonee, of Fort Wayne, an adopted half-sister Stella Brushwiller, also of Fort Wayne. One half-brother preceded him in death.

The remains were removed to the home of Mr. and Mrs. S. P. Sheets in Root township this morning. Mrs. Sheets is a sister to Mrs. Mallonee. Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon, short services at the Sheets home at 2 o'clock and from the Mt. Pleasant church at 2:30 p.m., the Rev. L. C. Wisher, officiating. Burial will be made in the Maplewood cemetery, Decatur.
