Paul McAhren, 68, dies at hospital

Paul L. McAhren, 68, of 1222 W. Madison street, former employe at the Decatur Casting Co. for 28 years and at the Pontiac Casting Co. for nine years, died at 2:24 p.m. Tuesday at the Adams county memorial hospital, following an extended illness. He resided in Decatur 42 years.

Mr. McAhren was a member of the St. Mark's United Methodist Church, serving as an usher for 15 years.

Born in Kirklin, Ind., on April 6, 1905, he was the son of Samuel and Emily Boyer-McAhren, and was married on May 23, 1931, to Geraldine Parrish, who survives.

Also surviving are one son, John Paul McAhren of Decatur; director of the Adams county welfare department; four grandchildren, Susan McAhren, Doris McAhren, Aleta McAhren and John McAhren; and two brothers, Leo McAhren and Raymond McAhren, both of route 5.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Winteregg-Linn funeral home, with Rev. Sylvester Martin and Rev. Fuhrman Miller officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery.
