Mrs. Helen Morgan dies this morning

Mrs. Helen Morgan, 51, wife of Clarence Morgan, 1624 West Monroe street, and a lifelong resident of Decatur, died at 10:45 a.m. today at the Adams county memorial hospital. She had been in failing health for the past 18 months.

Born in Decatur July 31, 1916, she was a daughter of Noah and Marie Teeple-Sheets, and graduated from Decatur high school in 1935. She was married to Clarence Morgan July 4, 1940.

Mrs. Morgan, a member of the Decatur Evangelical United Brethren church, was employed at the Decatur plant of the General Electric Co. until ill health forced her retirement in October of 1966.

Surviving are her husband; two sons, Pfc. Dennis M. Morgan, with the U.S. Army at Ft. Benjamin Harrison, Indianapolis, and K. Wayne Morgan, at home; four brothers, Robert, Doyle and David Sheets, all of Fort Wayne and Richard Sheets of Celina, O.; and two sisters, Mrs Don (Alice) Harman and Mrs. Lloyd (Martha) Reef, both of Decatur. A brother, Raymond, was killed in action during World War II in France Oct. 9, 1944.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Saturday at the Zwick funeral home, with Rev. Fuhrman Miller officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 7 p.m. Thursday until time of the services.
