DEWEY NEIDIGH DIES SUDDENLY TUESDAY

Heart Attack Fatal to G. E. Employee

Dewey Ernest Neidigh, 54, of Willshire, O., a veteran employee of the Decatur General Electric plant, died suddenly of a heart attack, at 5:15 o'clock EST Tuesday evening at a grocery store in Willshire.

Mr. Neidigh had been employed at the local G. E. plant for the past 25 years. The family lived in Decatur for many years, moving to Willshire about 12 years ago.

He was born in Bloomfield April 9, 1899, a son of Wesley and Annie Abrams Neidigh, and was married to Miss Winifred Gilpen in 1917.

Mr. Neidigh was a member of the Knights of Pythias lodge at Willshire.

Surviving are his wife: five sons, Paul of San Antonio, Tex., Douglas of Tucson, Ariz., Merlin, Wesley and Dewey, Jr., all at home; three grandchildren; and four brothers, Don, Cletus, Gerald and Clifford Neidigh, all of Bloomfield.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. EST Saturday at the residence and at 2:30 p.m. at the Willshire Church of God, the Rev. Herb Schumm and the Rev. Earl Thomas officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery. The body removed to the Black funeral home, will be returned to the residence, where friends may call after 7 o'clock this evening.
