

**Mrs. Ida Belle Ogg Is Taken By Death
Funeral Services Tuesday Afternoon**

Mrs. Ida Belle Ogg, 82, of 307 South Seventh street, died at 6:45 o'clock Saturday evening at the Adams county memorial hospital. She had been in failing health for six months and critically ill for the past three days. Death was attributed to complication.

She was born in Green county, Ky., May 10, 1875, a daughter of John and Anna Stimson-Womack. Her husband, George Ogg, died May 20, 1945.

Mrs. Ogg was a member of the First Baptist church.

Surviving are one son, Woodson Ogg of Decatur; three daughters, Mrs. Bessie Roop and Mrs. Lois Kohne, both of Decatur, and Mrs. Pearl Potts of Fort Wayne; 22 grandchildren; 28 great-grandchildren; one brother, Dick Womack of Logan, Utah, and a half-sister, Mrs. Adolph Baumann of Decatur. Funeral services will be conducted at 1:40 p.m. Tuesday at the residence and at 2 p.m. at the First Baptist church, the Rev. Stuart Brightwell officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery. The body, removed to the Black funeral home, has been returned to the residence, where friends may call until time of the services.
