Nora Parrish Expires Today

Decatur Woman Dies This Morning Following Several Weeks Illness

Mrs. Nora Kitson Parrish, 57, of this city, died at her home on West Elm Street at 12:20 o'clock this morning after a several week illness. Death was said to be due to heart trouble and complications. Mrs. Parrish had been in a serious condition for several days.

Nora Kitson Parrish was born in North Manchester, Indiana October 6, 1869. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Daniel Kitson. Later she moved to this county with her parents and in early life, she was united in marriage to Newton Parrish, who preceded her in death several years ago.

Mrs. Parrish was a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church of this city and was a member of the Eastern Star Lodge. Two children, Alice and Donald, preceded the mother in death.

She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Frank Rowley of this city, her stepmother, Mrs. Daniel Kitson of this city and the following brothers and sisters: Mrs. Charles Johnson and Mrs. Charles Gage, of Adams County; Charles Kitson, William Kitson of Decatur and Earl Kitson of Montana.
