

**MRS. CAL PETERSON DIES THIS MORNING**

Mrs. Ina P. Peterson, 85, wife of Cal E. Peterson, of 215 South Fifth Street, and a lifelong resident of the Decatur area, died at 8:30 o'clock this morning at the Adams county memorial hospital. She had been in failing health for several weeks.

Born in Van Wert county, O., Nov 25, 1878, she was the daughter of John and Lise Jane Roop-Everett. She was married to Cal E. Peterson, prominent Decatur businessman for many years, June 25, 1912. Mr. and Mrs. Peterson celebrated their golden wedding anniversary in 1962.

Mrs. Peterson was a member of the First Baptist church and the Women's Missionary society of the church. One of the most active church members, she taught in the nursery department of the Sunday school for many years, and also played the organ and sang in the church choir for a number of years.

Surviving in addition to her husband are several nieces and nephews, and a number of grand nieces and grand nephews. One brother is deceased.
