Mrs. Sarah Potts Dies This Morning

Mrs. Sarah C. Potts, 92, of 409 South 13th Street, a resident of Decatur most of her life, died at 7:03 a.m. today at Adams County Memorial Hospital, where she had been a patient for three months.

Born in Adams county Aug. 4, 1872, she was a daughter of Adam and Mary Ann Bates-Ault, and was married to Hiram Potts May 28, 1893. Her husband preceded her in death July 6, 1926. Mrs. Potts had made her home with a daughter, Mrs. Carl Schug of Salem, since September of 1961.

Mrs. Potts was a member of the Decatur Evangelical United Brethren (Trinity) Church.

Surviving are four sons, Ralph E. and Clarence W. Potts, both of Fort Wayne, Glen W. Potts of Decatur, Lawrence H. Potts of Columbia City; four daughters Mrs. Ben (Mary E.)
