Mrs. Donna D. Rowley, 70, of Monmouth, died at 6:58 a.m. today at the Adams county memorial hospital, where she had been a patient two weeks. She had been a resident of the Decatur Community Care Center since October.

Mrs. Rowley, who was retired, was the receptionist at Dr. Harold Zwick's office for many years; she was a member of the First United Methodist Church and a charter member of Psi Iota Xi sorority.

Born in Decatur on Jan. 25, 1904, she was the daughter of Newton and Nora Kitson-Parrish, and was married on Oct. 5, 1925, to Frank L. Rowley, who died May 13, 1963.

Survivors include one son, James L. Rowley of Belvedere, S. C., and five grandchildren. One brother and one sister preceded her in death.
