

**Dr. Harold F. Zwick**

**Decatur - 1909-2001**

Dr. Harold F. Zwick, 92, of Decatur, a physician and surgeon, died Sunday, Dec. 2, 2001, at Woodcrest.

The Adams County native had retired from practice in 1988 after more than 52 years of service and had served as the medical director at Lakeside Nursing Home for several years. He had been chief of staff at Adams County Memorial Hospital, and was a member of Zion Lutheran Church where he sang in the church choir and men's choir. He was a charter member of Lutheran Chorale, a 50-year member of American Legion Adams Post 43 and Lions Club. He was a World War II U.S. Army veteran and a recipient of the Bronze Star. Surviving are daughters Maryann Cowans of Decatur and Barbara J. Johnson of Fort Wayne; a son, Dr. H. Frederick Jr. of Whitehall, Wis.; six grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife, Helen N., three sisters and a brother. Services are 11 a.m. Thursday at Zion Lutheran Church, Decatur, with calling one hour before services. Calling is also from 1 to 8 p.m. Wednesday at Zwick & Jahn Funeral Home, Decatur. Burial with military graveside services will be at Decatur Cemetery.
