Joseph A Emenhiser was born on December 15, 1819 in Titusville, Crawford County, Pennsylvania. His parents are Adam and Catherine (Reese) Emenhiser. He later moved to VanWert, Gallia County, Ohio where he married Nancy Adeline Clark on February 4, 1846. They had 18 children: Virginia, Martha, Mary, Adam, James, Nancy, Joseph, Margaret, John, Adeline, William, Abigail, Stephen, Sarah, Araminta, Arometa, David, and Delilah. Around 1860 they moved to Madison Township, Allen County, Indiana. There they lived as farmers. Joseph was one of the best known pioneer farmers in Allen County. Joseph died on February 20, 1895. He was found dead out in the barn yard on the ground. It is said that he slipped and fell on the ice. He was known for being a wealthy man, with a value around \$20,000 to \$25,000. Joseph was buried in Antioch Lutheran Cemetery in Hoagland, Allen County Indiana.
