They had many Swiss neighbors who would bring their cow's milk over for Peter and Anna Marie to make cheese with. Peter would travel to Ft. Wayne to sell his cheese. He didn't speak English well, so he would bring John along with him to translate. John later carried on the cheese making business.

John was very smart in matters of land and farming. He bought many areas of land and he would build buildings and farm on his new land. He met Lena Reinhart and married her on February 26, 1884. They had 13 children; Bertha, Fred, William, John Jr., Joel, Fannie, Emma, Alma, David, Daniel, Queenie, Elizabeth, and Lillian. He was a member of the Apostolic Church. He later died on June 10, 1947.

John J. was born to Andrew and Marie (Wierman) Fiechter on June 27, 1859 in Wayne County, OH, soon after they moved to the United States. He was the fourth out of five children. He was their only son. After Andrew's drowning John worked hard to support his family, because his mother had to survive on her meager pension. When John was 10 they moved to Wells County, IN. John was known for his delicious Swiss Cheese. John married Lena Reinhart, her last name is also registered as Reinhard, their wedding date is unknown. They were active there in the Apostolic Christian Church of Newville. Newville's name was later changed to Vera Cruz, the church's name changed to Apostolic Christian Church of Bluffton. The church was on the Wells County/ Adams County line. Together they had 13 children, Bertha, Fred, William, John J. Jr, Joel, Frannie, Emma, David, Daniel, Alma, Queenie, Elizabeth, and Lillian. John was a farmer and a cheese maker, his swiss cheese was well known. They lived where Doug and Jill Fiechter still live today. Lena died in 1942, he died on June 10, 1947. They were buried side by side in the Apostolic Christian Cemetery across the road from the Apostolic Christian church.
