Earl Frauhiger was born on April 8, 1909 in Adams County, Indiana. He became a member of the Apostolic Christian Church as a teenager. Earl married Anna Neuenschwander on Nov. 24, 1940. Once they were wed they moved to Wells County, Indiana. The couple had 5 children: Doyle, Charles(Chuck), Wanita, Dale, and Chauncy. Earl was a construction worker and a farmer. He was not accepted into World War II because of a leg injury that occurred earlier in his life. When Earl was 8 years of age he was watching his younger brother Homer when he fell asleep. When Earl woke up he found Homer drowned in the horse tank. Earl was always a very skilled and particular carpenter. At age 75 Earl became legally blind. On July 15, 1994 Earl died in his home.
