Sir Andrew Gray, Baron Broxmouth, was born in about 1253 A.D. His date of death is unknown. He lived and died in Broxmouth, Roxburghshire, Scotland. His father was Sir Hugh Gray, Knight and his mother is unknown. He married a woman named Ada Giffard of Yester and had 2 children, Sir David de Gray and Thomas de Gray. Sir Andrew Gray followed King Robert Bruce in the War of Independence. He received, from the monarch, a grant of all the lands and tenements that belonged to Edmund de Hastings. He had a charter from Alexander Fraser confirming that owned many merks of land in the tenement of Broxmouth in about 1321.
