Adam Phillip Massoth was born May 26th, 1873, in Hanover Center, Lake County, Indiana. He was baptized and christened on May 26th in St. Martin's Catholic church in Hanover Center, Lake County, Indiana. His parents were Johann Adam Massoth and Mary Anna (Long) Massoth. His godparents were Adam Gerold and Elisabeth Geisen. Adam married Elisabeth ("Lizzie") (Biegel) Massoth on May 9th, 1899 in St. Martin's Catholic church in Hanover Center, Lake County, Indiana. He and Elisabeth had 19 children together. Eugene, Walter, Paul, Peter, Agnes, Martha, Theresa Anna, Raymond Joseph, Phillip Peter, Marie Catherine, Cecilia Eleanor, Jerome James, Rapheal Emil, Peter Sylvester, Joseph, and Veron, 16 of which survived infancy. Much of what Adam did in the working world isn't recorded, but he served his country in World War I. Sometime between 1920 and 1930 he moved his family to Hanover, Lake County, Indiana. Adam died October 9th, 1958 in Cedar Lake, Lake County, Indiana.
