### Christian P. Neuenschwander

Christian P. Neuenschwander was born on November 23, 1812 in Latan, Berne, Switzerland. His main occupations were farming and shoe making. He was the first of the Neuenschwanders to leave Switzerland and immigrate to the United States.

Christian was 30 years old when he left Europe. His journey to immigrate to the United States started at a shipping port in Le Havre, France. He departed on a boat called the Herculean, which took sail for New York City. Then he went from New York to Adams County, Indiana. He married Anna Lehman and had eight children, Christiana, Jacob, Rachel, Adaline, Christian, Abram, David, and Anna. Christian died when he was 72 years old on November 5, 1884 and is buried at the MRE cemetery in Berne, Indiana.
