Otto Neuenschwander was born on October 11, 1881 in Adams County, Indiana. He worked as a carpenter in Berne, Indiana. He would farm some with his father Christian, but he branched out on his own doing carpentry work. He married Mathilda Luginbill in Adams County, Indiana. Otto resided in Adams County his whole life. They had three children. Their names were Gladys, Lenora, and Ellison. He taught his son, Ellison, the trade of carpentry which including upholstering furniture. Otto attended church and was considered a Mennonite. He died when he was 80 years old on March 23, 1961 in Adams County, Indiana. He is buried at the MRE cemetery in Berne, Indiana.
