Nicolas (Stucki) Stucky

Nicolas Stucki was born on April 6, 1790, in Bourbach-le-Bas, France. Being the oldest of his siblings, when his father passed away, he signed the certificate of death on June 25, 1839.

Nicolas married Barbara Futiger. She blessed Nicolas with 9 children: Barbara, Nicholas, Jakob (Jacob), Christian, Katherine, Benjamin, Anna, Christine, and Verena. Barbara died on June 15, 1842 during childbirth.

Nicolas and his family came to America on the *Memphis*. The ship arrived in New York City on September 15, 1846. When coming to America, Nicolas changed his last name from Stucki to Stucky.

He and his family settled in Adams County Indiana, where he purchased 144.6 acres for \$350 near Linn Grove. Nicolas' occupation in Indiana was a farmer. He was a member of the Mennonite church. Nicolas passed away on August 22, 1857 in Linn Grove, Adams County, Indiana. He is buried in the Moser Cemetery in the French Township.
