Vaughn Elsworth Truelove was born on May 2, 1912 to Albert and Lorena (Simon) Truelove. He was born and raised until the age of eight in Avilla, Indiana. He and his family then moved to Nobel County Indiana where he lived with his parents. Vaughn and his brother, Laurence, started a business in 1938 that is still open today. The Truelove brothers sold and repaired farm equipment. He married Beatrice Flossie Bauman on February 4, 1933. The two married in Kendallville Indiana. The newlyweds stayed in Nobel County Indiana and had three daughters, Jane, Janis, and Nyla. The Truelove family attended a local church in Nobel County weekly and would do their socializing at church related events. Vaughn stayed in Nobel County even after his wife passed away in 2000. Eight years later, at the age of 95, Vaughn also passed away in St. Petersburg, Florida. The family had his body sent back to Indiana where he could be buried in Albion with the diseased Beatrice.
