

## C E REDIGER JOINS JOHNSTON

## Becomes Associate Pastor-Evangelist of People's Gospel Tabernacle

Ft. Wayne, Nov. 26—The Rev. C. E. Rediger, of Bluffton, O., who served as pastor-evangelist of the Fort Wayne Gospel Temple for a short time following the death of his brother, the Rev. B. E. Rediger, founder of the temple, has become associate pastor-evangelist of the People's Tabernacle here, Dr. DeWitt Johnston, tabernacle pastor-evangelist, announced Saturday.

The Rev. Mr. Rediger will preach his first sermons as associate pastorevangelist Sunday afternoon and night, Dec. 2. He will continue his work as financial agent at Bluffton College and will make his home there. The pastor served for three months at the Gospel Temple here in 1931 and 1932. He then became pastor of the Mennonite Gospel Tabernacle in Chicago and remained there until going to Bluffton College last September.
