The marriage ceremony will take place on Saturday, April 10, at the home of the bride's mother. A reception will be held at the home of Mrs. Della Dexter, 123 East Creighton Avenue, with whom the bride-elect makes her home here.

The bride-elect was graduated from the Bluffton High School and now is employed by the Lincoln National Life Insurance Company. Mr. Rudy is a graduate of the Bluffton High School and Purdue University at West Lafayette. He belonged to Phi Kappa Tau Fraternity at Purdue and Miss Neuenschwander is a member of Beta Nu Chapter of Pi Omicron Sorority here.
