Former Parochial School Master Succeeds Paul Spuller

J. D. R. Schwartz of 165 Bryan Street was named teacher of the fifth grade by the Berne Board of Education at a meeting Friday evening. He succeeds Paul Spuller who resigned recently to accept a position as English teacher in the Justin Study School at Fort Wayne.

Mr. Schwartz, a son of former Bishop David Schwartz, north of Berne, has been teaching for the past several years in Adams county schools. During the past two years he taught the No. 2 school, known as the Sackett school near Monroe. Prior to that he taught in the No. 4 school known at the Beer school and prior to that he served as the teacher of the parochial school, known as the Amish school, northwest of Berne for 14 years.

He has his degree from Ball State Teachers college at Muncie and he and his family moved to Berne about a year ago.
