From Morehead, follow US 60E into Carter County, through Globe to Smith Run Road; turn left and go 3.5 miles on Smith Run Rd. to gravel road at left (road sign marked on, but believe it's Rose Ridge Road); turn left and follow this gravel road 0.15 mile to cemetery road; go right 0.05 mile uphill on cemetery road to cemetery on left. (Overlooks I-64).

Established 1859. Several unmarked graves.
