I, Francis Lane, aged 19 years, occupation Farmer, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color White, complexion Fair, height 5 feet 9 inches, weight 170 pounds, color of hair Brown, color of eyes Brown, other visible distinctive marks None

I was born in Limerick, Ireland on the 10th day of July, anno Domini 1900, I now reside at 312 West Silver Street, Butte, Montana

I emigrated to the United States of America from Liverpool, England on the vessel Haverford; my last foreign residence was Limerick, Ireland; I am not married; the name of my wife is: she was born at and now resides at

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to George V King of Great Britain and Ireland, of whom I am now a subject;

I arrived at the port of Philadelphia, in the State of Penn., on or about the 4th day of April, anno Domini 1920. I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein: SO HELP ME GOD.
