Know all men by these presents that we **Samuel Orr of Carlagan in the County of Monaghan, farmer, Robert Orr of Muhuaidghuby, Carpenter and Alexander Orr of Bellaheagh in County of Armagh, weaver, and Alexander Whiteraft of Glassknow in the County of Monaghan farmer and Ann Whiteraft other wise Orr his wife,** all in the Kingdom of Ireland for divers good Causes and Considerations we hereunto moving have made Ordained nominated Constituted and appointed and by these presents do make ordain nominate Constitute and appoint **Thomas Orr of Bellaheagh in the County of Armagh now aged about twenty one years** our true and Lawful attorney for us and in our place and Stead and for our ___ to ask demand and receive all and every sum and sums of money and all and every of the property of every kind and description That we all and every of us That we may be entitled unto from the administrator administrators of **Wm Orr** formerly of **Gleneheim** in the said County of **Monaghan** and lately of **South Carolina** in **America** where the said **William Orr** laterly died and to whereto property we the Said **Samuel Orr, Robert Orr, Alexander Orr and Ann Whiteraft** all were in___de the **Brothers and sister of the said William** now stand entitled unto and of and from every other person or persons liable to or entitled to pay any sum or sums of money due to the said **William Orr** at the time of his death or that had any ___ property of the said **William** in their hands, power or possession at such time and we do hereby empower the said **Thomas Orr** our true and Lawful Attorney for us and in our names and so Knowing in the property of the said **William Orr** deceased in our names and for our uses to give acquittance acquitances for the same and every part thereof and in Case any person or persons have or Shall possess themselves of the whole or any part of the property of said **William Orr**, demand and Shall decline or refuse handing over same Then and in Such Case we do hereby authorize and empower the said **Thomas Orr** to employ one or more attorney or attorneys to proceed in all and every They shall think proper and further we do authorize and empower our Said Attorney to sell assign and Convey all or any part of landed Interest That said **William Orr** did possessed of or entitled and at the time of his death and to Execute any deed or deeds of Conveyance he may think necessary and give receipt or receipts for the Consideration surely giving unto the said **Thomas Orr** all and every power we or any of us could have as fully and as amply as if we and each of us was or were personally present to ratifying and confirming all and every act that shall or may be done in and about the premises by

the said Thomas Orr, our Lawful attorney who we and each of us do fully impower to act manage and dispose of the property of said William Orr deceased as he shall think proper. Given under our hands and Seals at **Mareaghen in the County of Monaghan** in that part of the united Kingdom Called Ireland the **seventeenth day of April one thousand Eight hundred and four**. and due to pay any sum or sum of money due to the said William Orr at the time of his death or that
had any other property of the said William in their hands power or possession at such time and so
do hereby empower the said Thomas Orr our true and Lawfull Attorney for us and in our names and so
knowing in this property of the said William Orr deceased in our names and for our use to give Request
and an Acknowledgment for the same and every part thereof and in Case any person or persons have or
shall have any property of the whole or any part of the property of said William Orr deceased and
shall decline or refuse to pay over or deliver the same we do hereby authorize and
