I've used the slash mark as above or a question mark to offer another possibility.

Potter, Elizabeth Reul / Read and William F.? Potter, his children, and James F. Read, William D. Read, Mary E. Read and John H. Read children of Jane Read deceased, who was the daughter of the said Thomas Potter and Martha Jane Shanks and Jesse B. D. Shanks, children of Huldah Shanks deceased, who was also a daughter of the said Thomas Potter, that the said Martha Jane Shanks and Jesse B. D. Shanks reside in Atchison County in the State of Missouri, and that all the other heirs reside in Clinton County in the State of Missouri; that the said Thomas Potter died without a will; that he, this deponent, will make a perfect inventory of, and faithfully administer all the estate of the said Thomas Potter, and pay the debts as far as the assets will extend and the law direct, and account for and pay all assets which shall come to his possession or knowledge.
