Dear Gov

I take my pen to ask of you the privilege of working for or Com in the next Regt A Volenteers. I got some papers at Bangor at the place to which you directed me. If you allow me to scarh for the next Regt Volenteers I shall want you to send me six descriptive lists. I should like to concentrate my men at Newport if it, would be as well as Augusta. I should like also to have some notices with my name on them. One thing in particular I wish you to inform me of the Volenteers rec'd of one fourth of the bounty [which was to be payed] to them at close of the War when mustered into USS. Please answer as soon as convenient.
