Have requested the creditors to delay sending the execution to Boston until you could, receive information. One of the judgments in favor of the Folsom of this town is about \$73.00. The other upon a note enclosed to the inhabitants of Augusta is about \$36. Mr Wales the bearer has a note for about \$22 given to Judkins and by him endowed.

If it be your wish to discharge these debts or any of them you may give Mr Wales or nearly their sum as convenient and I will attend to their discharge.
