Twenty acres more or less.

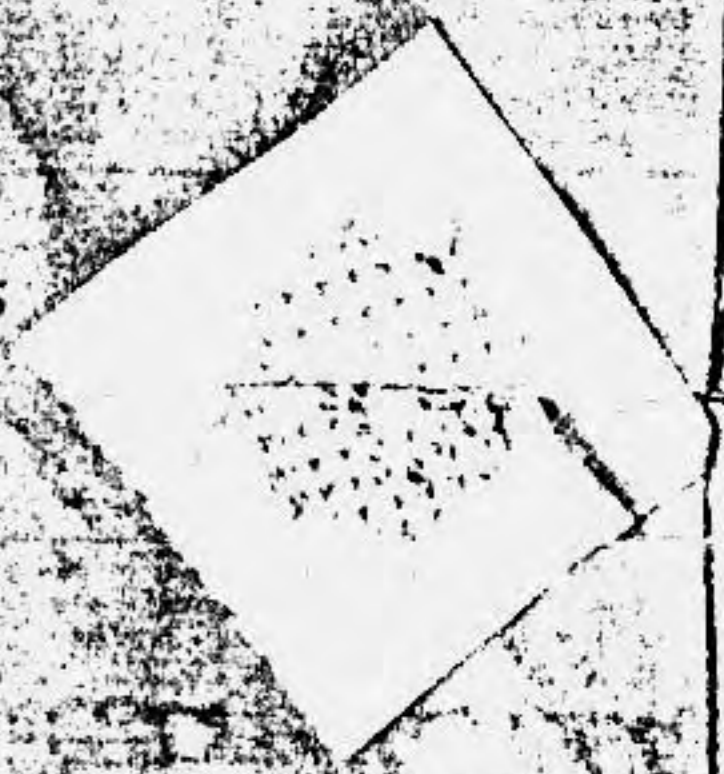
To have and to hold the
