DATE: Tuesday, June 4, 2013, at 6:00 P.M. at the Masonic Temple in Flint, Michigan.

President, Jim Newman, welcomed members and guests to our annual dinner meeting. He introduced special guest, Doreen Fulcher, senior Deputy Clerk at the Genesee County Courthouse.

Jim announced that the Flint Genealogical Society was planning a trip to the Allen County Library in Ft. Wayne, Indiana, on October 15th and 16th, 2013. The cost is \$35.00 for members and \$40.00 for non-members. Room rates will be the same as in the past at \$52.00 for a single and \$60.00 for a double.

Jim also noted that the LaGrange County Public Library is sponsoring a Genealogy Research trip to Washington, D.C. on October 21 – 25, 2013. MGC Delegate, Lorene Wilson, announced that the Michigan Genealogical Council is urging its members to raise funds to help defray the cost of digitizing and saving pension records from the War of 1812. 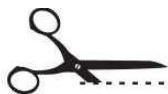
