Dr. Grace Bliss Smith is a retired educator and author. She was born in Detroit and has been married to Russell Smith for 47 years. They are the parents of two children and five grandchildren, ages seven to nineteen.

Grace's interests include history, travel, live theatre, genealogy, technology, and reading.

She is the immediate past Regent of the Louisa St. Clair Chapter, DAR, a member of the State Speakers Staff, and State Historian for the Michigan Society. She has 16 proven DAR patriots and is always looking for more. Grace has pursued her strong interest in family history by researching, proving, and then honoring her ancestors in several hereditary societies. Along with her DAR service, she currently serves as Deputy Governor of the Society of Mayflower Descendants in Michigan and President of the General Alexander Macomb Chapter, United States Daughters of 1812. She also serves as Michigan Society President of the Daughters of Colonial Wars, and President of the Michigan Court, *National Society of Women Descendants of the Ancient and Honorable Artillery Company*.
