Joe is a US Army combat wounded Vietnam Veteran. He is a retired Holly High School teacher who taught History, Government and Drama. Joe has a Bachelor's from Central Michigan and Masters of Liberal Studies – American Cultures from UofM Flint. He is currently the Chairperson of the Friends of the McFarlan Veterans Memorial Park, Chairperson of the Holly Education Foundation and the newly created Karl Richter Community Center in Holly. Joe is an author, a playwright, a consultant, a lecturer/presenter, a grant writer, a project organizer, and has directed over 100 musicals and plays. He is a member of the Great Lakes National Cemetery Advisory Board, and a mentor with the Genesee County Veterans Treatment Court. The 1897 - 1920 Michigan Death Certificates have already been available.

The 1921 - 1939 Michigan Death Certificates are now on the site as of March 17, 2015.

The 1940 1952 are indexed, but due to privacy restrictions 1940 will be released in January 2016 ... 1941 in January 2017, etc.

The Detroit News Indexes

Originally compiled by The Detroit News, this subject index of The Detroit News newspaper totals more than 1 million index cards. The tables of PDF files below are arranged alphabetically by subject and date approximately from the late 1800's to the late 1990's.

An index card here at Seeking Michigan indicates that there is a clipping file for those articles. Researchers may then request to look in the clippings file here at the Archives of Michigan for the actual articles cited or visit a research institution that has the newspaper on microfilm. At this time, the Archives of Michigan does not have a set of The Detroit News on microfilm.

Because the cards are organized by subject, researchers should be prepared to look for any number of different headings.
