

The Flint Genealogical Society General Membership Meeting was called to order at 7:13 p.m., 5 May 2015 at the Burton Senior Citizens Center by President Della Gamalski.

President Della Gamalski led all present in the pledge to the American Flag.

Treasurer, Pam Smith, reported that the society had a balance of \$42,149.75 as of April 30, 2015. Income for the month was \$436.86, with expenses of \$1,832.64. Leaving a net loss of \$1,395.78 for the month.

Secretary's report was approved and placed on file.

Old Business:

Ft. Wayne Trip - Judy Newman reported only 17 persons had paid and the rental of a 15 passenger van and a 7 passenger car would be used for the trip unless many more persons signed up in the next day or two. Mr. Battle, the contact for First Class Transportation, had been called and advised that we wouldn't be needing his services.

Annual Dinner - June 2, 2015, 6 p.m. - Tickets are \$18.00 each and are available tonight from Amy Hubbard. The banquet will be at the Flint Masonic Temple, 755 S. Saginaw St, Flint. No tickets will be sold at the door.

Voting for the changes in the bylaws of the society were under the leadership of Dan Pozarek. Chris Venturino and Judy Newman assisted. The changes were approved.

New Business:

Judge Jennie Barkey was the guest speaker, talking about the items her court handles including probates of wills, estates trust supervision, adults guardianships and conservatorships, protective orders, and hearing for minors. She handles mental health services such as adult and juvenile mental health and veteran's treatment court. Some of the non traditional matters she handles includes juvenile guardianships and conservatorships as well as juvenile protective orders. Two of the most pleasurable duties is handling adoptions and performing weddings. Judge Barkey was a most interesting speaker and answered questions both from the floor and privately.
