

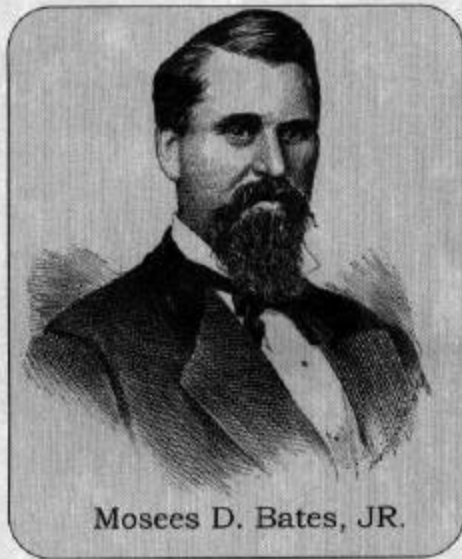
**The Reprinting of:
