The condition of the above Obligation is such, That if there should be no legal cause to obstruct a Marriage shortly to be solemnized between the above bond *Abraham A Harrison* and *Susan E Allston* for which a license this day issued, then the above obligation to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue in law.
