Loa/Loie Hulda Rice Dinnel

died at her home in Midvale Precinct, Sunday night Dec 20, 1903.

Mrs John Dinnel, death came suddenly. Two weeks ago it was thought she was dying and was so reported but she rallied and was seemingly on the road to rapid recovery when the summons came. She leaves four small children, a husband, brother, sister, and father to mourn her departure. Funeral services were held Tuesday at the home and the body was laid to rest in the Westside cemetery. (This cemetery is located about 11 miles east of Burwell, Ne in a pasture)

More about her death;

After giving birth to the twins, she developed an infection.

Her husband John couldn't care for the children. So they were given

to others for adoption. Cecile was given to a neighbor ... 4 year old Jack

went to live first with a maiden lady then was adopted by Will and Nettie

Tetschner, and Iva and Ivan were adopted by Mr and Mrs Reed Waters.

Loie's mother died in 26 November just a little over three weeks before her

death. So her father lost both his wife and this daughter in less than a months time.
