PARTRIDGE, A. H.

A. H. Partridge was a pioneer of Garfield county, coming here in 1887. He was born in Iowa City, Ia., in June of 1869. Mrs. Partridge was born in Wahoo in January 1886.

This couple was married Dec. 31, 1900, living five miles east of Burwell for six years then moving into Burwell where Mr. Partridge took up the plumbing business and well drilling. At that time very few wells and windmills were here so he was a busy man. He was in active business for 46 years. He put down over 3,000 wells, some of which were 300 feet deep, and hundreds of shallow wells, besides the windmills he sold and erected. He had six sons who served in World War II, two sons-in-law and one grandson.

One son, Darell, is a plumber in Boston, Mass., and one son, Keith, is a plumber in Seattle, Wash. The other boys helped their father at one time or another in the plumbing business but decided to go into other fields of work.

This couple had 14 children — eight sons and six daughters. They lived to celebrate their golden wedding anniversary. They were always interested in civic matters, schools and all that concerned them and theirs. They lived in this county all their lives. Mrs. Partridge died in 1955 and Mr. Partridge in 1959.

Mrs. Inez Davis and Mrs. Effie Brennehan are the only members of the Partridge family in Burwell at this time.
