

SUSAN CONARD WHITE

Susan Conard was born near Franklin Grove, in Lee County, Ill., July 7, 1849, and departed this life March 15, 1924, at the home of Mrs. Cora Fuss, in Ord, at the age of 74 years, 8 months and 8 days. She was united in marriage to George White in 1871. To this union two sons were born, Eugene of Burwell and Raymond of Maryville, Mo.; who died in 1901. They were among the early settlers of Garfield county. She united with the Methodist church while young and was a devoted wife and mother. Her husband preceded her in death having died Oct. 13, 1917. She is survived by her son Eugene, 7 grandchildren, 3 brothers and 1 sister. The brothers are Daniel of Hanford, Calif., Jonas, of Newport, Nebr. and Phillip, of Burwell, and the sister Mary Blake, of Burwell. The funeral was conducted at the West Side school house by Rev. Maynard of Ord and the body was laid to rest in the West Side Cemetery.

OBITUARY

George White an old and respected citizen of this county died at his home fourteen miles north east of Burwell, Tuesday afternoon, Oct. 16, 1917. Deceased was born in Bedford County, Pa., in 1847. He moved to Bureau County, Illinois, in 1871, where he was united in marriage to Susan Connard. He came to Nebraska in the winter 1890.

Two sons were born to them, Raymond, who died at the age of 16, and Eugene were the children of the deceased. One brother, Frank White, of Waco, Nebr., and his cousin, J. T. Kegariss, of Atlanta, Ia. were with the widow and son to mourn the loss of their father, husband and brother. Short prayer was held at the home, services at the West Side School house and committal at the West Side Cemetery were conducted by Rev. Pinkham, Pastor of the M. E. Church at Burwell. The services were most impressive and the singing was especially fine.
