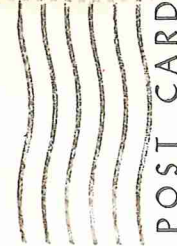
"THE THREE BRICKS" or THE STARBUCK HOUSES P4954

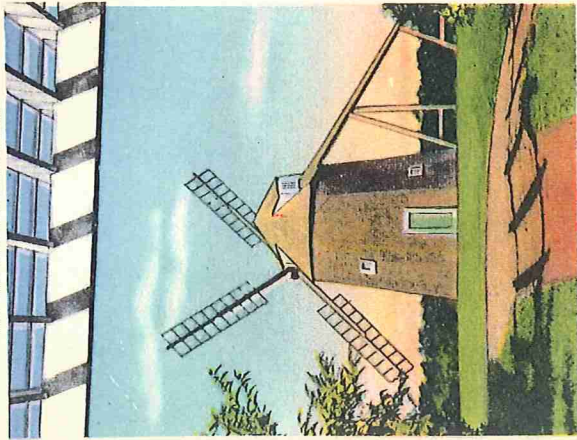

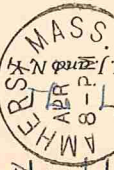

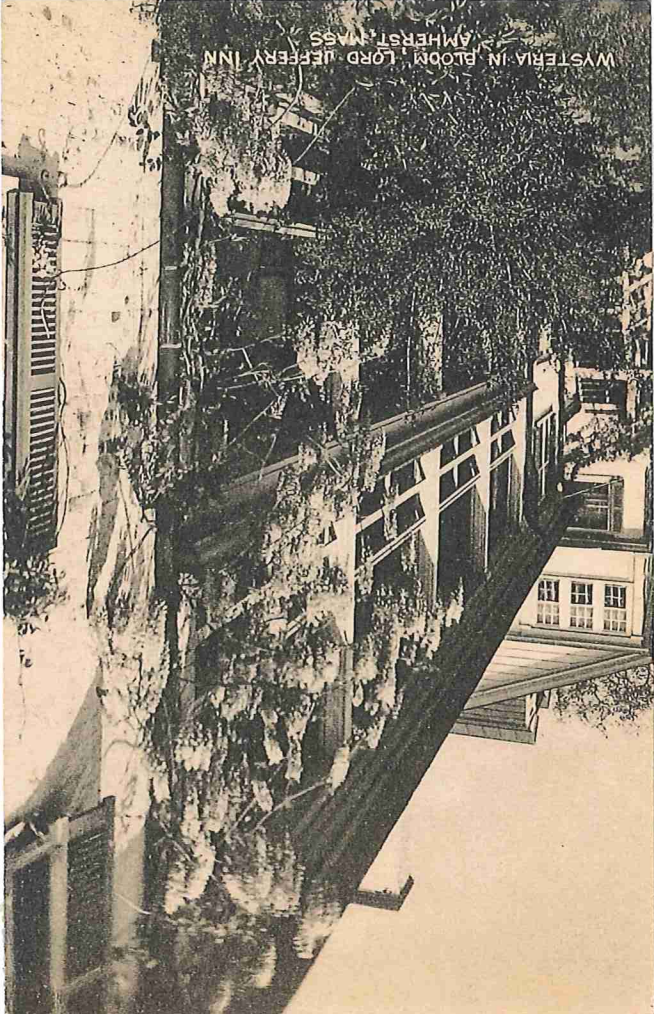
